Director of Veterans Service	-	17,500.00
Director of Planning	-	25,000.00
County Highway Superintendent	-	30,773.00

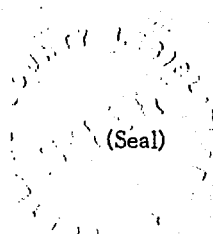
