A Local Law Establishing the Department
of Central Services.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF
CORTLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Department of Central Services in and for the
County of Cortland is hereby created and established.

Section 2: The head of said Department shall be the Director
of Central Services who shall be appointed by and serve at the
pleasure of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cortland.
Said Director of Central Services shall be paid an annual salary
for his services in an amount and installments as shall from time
to time be provided by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of
the County of Cortland,

Section 3: The Department of Central Services shall have the
power to provide for, manage and operate county printing, data
processing, mailing, record reproduction and storage and staff
and equip said department as the same may be authorized by the Board
of Supervisors and perform such other duties and functions as shall
be required or delegated to it by the Board of Supervisors by
Resolution.

Section 4: This Local Law shall take effect immediately.




