### LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1976

A LOCAL LAW OF CORTLAND COUNTY PURSUANT TO

ARTICLE 24 OF THE NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROTECTION, PRESERVATION AND CONSERVATION

OF THE FRESHWATER WETLANDS WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Cortland as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to #24-0501 of the New York State Freshwater Wetlands Act (Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law), the County of Cortland shall fully undertake and exercise its regulatory authority with regard to activities subject to regulation under the Act in freshwater wetlands, as shown on the Freshwater Wetlands Map, as such map may from time to time be amended, filed by the Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to the Act, and in all areas adjacent to any such freshwater wetland up to 100 feet from the boundary of such wetland. Such regulatory authority shall be undertaken and exercised in accordance with all of the procedures, concepts and definitions set forth in Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law and Title 23 of Article 71 of such law relating to the enforcement of Article 24, as such law may from time to time be amended.

a. Wetlands shall be subject to regulation by the County only in those towns, villages or the City of Cortland in which the respective municipal authority has failed to adopt and implement protective local laws or ordinances as prescribed by Article 24-0501(4); or in those towns, villages or the City of Cortland wherein the respective municipal authority requests in writing that the authority for regulation be transferred to the county as prescribed in Article 24-0503(1); or in those towns, villages or the City of Cortland in which the Commissioner of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation finds and declares that a town, village or city does not possess the technical capacity or is not effectively administering the provision of the Act, as prescribed in Section 24-0503(2), and orders that the function be transferred to the County of Cortland.

SECTION 2. This law, adopted on the date set forth below, shall take effect upon the filing with the clerk of Cortland County of the final Freshwater Wetlands Map by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to 24-0301 of the Freshwater Wetlands Act applicable to any or all lands with the County of Cortland.

### ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1976

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 3 for the Year 1976, Providing for the Protection, Preservation and Conservation of the Freshwater Wetlands within its boundaries was introduced by Mr. Phillips, a member of the Legislature at the meeting of this Legislature held on November 8, 1976, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form upon the desks of the members at least seven calendars days, exclusive of Sunday prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature after publication of a notice thereof as required by law, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Local Law No. 3 for the Year 1976, which Local Law provides for the Protection, Preservation and Conservation of the Freshwater Wetlands within its boundaries, be passed and enacted in the following form:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to #24-0501 of the New York State Freshwater Wetlands Act (Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law), the County of Cortland shall fully undertake and exercise its regulatory authority with regard to activities subject to regulation under the Act in freshwater wetlands, as shown on the Freshwater Wetlands Map, as such map may from time to time be amended, filed by the Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to the Act, and in all areas adjacent to any such freshwater wetland up to 100 feet from the boundary of such wetland. Such regulatory authority shall be undertaken and exercised in accordance with all of the procedures, concepts and definitions set forth in Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law and Title 23 of Article 71 of such law relating to the enforcement of Article 24, as such law may from time to time be amended.

a. This Law, adopted on the date set forth below, shall take effect upon the filing with the Clerk of Cortland County of the final Freshwater Wetlands Map by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to 24-0301 of the Freshwater Wetlands Act applicable to any or all lands with the County of Cortland.
