SECTION 1. Subdivision 7b of Local Law No. 1 for the year 1956, as amended by Local Law No. 2 for the year 1963 and further amended by Local Law No. 6 for the year 1975, be and hereby is amended to read:

7b. A self insurance contributed reserve is hereby established for the Cortland County Self Insurance Plan. The maximum amount which may be contributed to such reserve shall be Five Hundred Thousand Dollars.

SECTION 2. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
