Section 1. The County of Cortland does hereby elect to change the administration of the Civil Service in the County of Cortland from existing Civil Service Commission to that of Personnel Officer of the County of Cortland, as provided for in Section 15 of the Civil Service Law of the State of New York.

Section 2. The office of County Personnel Officer in the County of Cortland, State of New York be, and the same hereby is created, and the Cortland County Legislature shall designate and appoint a suitable person to fill such office.

Section 3. The term of office of the Personnel Officer of the County of Cortland shall be six (6) years.

Section 4. The compensation for the office of County Personnel Officer shall be fixed by Resolution of the Cortland County Board of Legislators prior to making such appointment.

Section 5. The Personnel Officer of the County of Cortland shall have all the powers and duties of the existing municipal Civil Service Commission, as provided for in Section 16 of the Civil Service Law of the State of New York, and such other powers and duties as may be granted or imposed by statute or resolution of the Board of Legislators of the County of Cortland, provided however, that said Board shall not grant or impose powers or duties inconsistent with any statutory provisions.

Section 6. The Personnel Officer of the County of Cortland shall assume all the duties and responsibilities presently carried out by the Personnel Director of the County of Cortland.

Section 7. This local law shall take effect on January 1, 1984 and upon full compliance with the provisions of the Civil Service Law and the Municipal Home Rule Law.
