RESCINDING LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1976

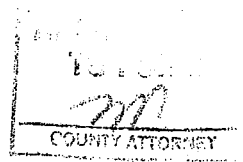

Freshwater Wetlands Act (Article 24 of the N.Y.S. Environmental Conservation Law) was introduced by Mr. Parker, a member of this Legislature at the time of this Legislative session held on November 25, 1986, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in the view of the Legislators at least seven days, exclusive of Sunday, prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before the Legislature after publication of notice thereof as required by law, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT
